

## **COVID-19 Safety Guidelines-Player/Parent Expectations**

Woodland Little League (WLL) has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, WLL cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19. Participating in or attending games and practices could increase the players/parent's risk of contracting COVID-19. We are striving to maximize safety for our players and coaches, while providing a sense or normalcy for the kids.

Our safety requirements and guidelines are subject to change based on changes recommended or required by local, state, and federal health agencies.

WLL players/parents must agree to the following safety guidelines to participate in or attend WLL activities:

- 1) Conduct a daily health assessment prior to coming to practices/games. The CDC has a self-assessment too (htps://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/index.html). Players should NOT attend practices or games if they are sick, have a fever, or had any COVID-19 symptoms.
- 2) Players who are sick with COVID-19 symptoms, but have not test positive may return when
  - a. They have had no fever for 3 full days AND
  - b. 7 days have passed since the symptoms first appeared.
- 3) Any player who tests positive with the Covid-19 virus cannot return to play until:
  - a. 10 days have passed after testing positive and
  - b. 24 hours with no fever and
  - c. Symptoms are improving
- 4) Any player who comes in close contact with a person who tests positive with the Covid-19 virus cannot return to play until:
  - a. 10 days have passed after coming into contact with a person who tested positive for COVID-19 or
  - b. 7 days have passes with proof of a negative test (5 days have passed since infection)

Each parent will also be required to sign attached waiver regarding return to play and acknowledgment of the rules.



Waiver

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

Attendance & participation at any Woodland Little League practices and games is 100% voluntary & not a requirement. WLL cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending WLL baseball practices could increase your risk and your child(ren)'s risk of contracting COVID-19.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren) and I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending practices or games and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at events may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, WLL coaches, volunteers, and players and their families.

I am 18 years or older and the parent/legal guardian of the Player. I understand the legal consequences of signing this document, including (a) releasing the Releasees from all liability on my and the players behalf, (b) promising not to sue on my and the Players behalf, (c) and assuming all risks of the Players/Parents participation in practices/games. I have read this two-page document, and I am signing freely.
